Likewise, if _____ does currently have a legal nonpermanent immigration status, he/she being duly sworn, deposes and says that he/she has filed an application to begin the process towards U.S. citizenship or will file such an application as soon as he/she is eligible to do so. _____ further deposes and says that, to the best of his/her knowledge, he/she is not eligible to enroll in a public postsecondary educational institution located in another state upon payment of tuition and fees required of residents of such state.

Any individual who: (1) Files an affidavit which contains false information; (2) fails to file an application to legalize such person's immigration status within one year of becoming eligible; (3) fails to begin the process for citizenship within one year of becoming eligible; or (4) fails to maintain an active application for citizenship after filing therefore shall not be deemed a resident of the state of Kansas for the purpose of tuition and fees. In addition, such individual shall be required to repay the difference between the amount of fees and tuition actually paid and the amount such person would have paid as a nonresident of the state of Kansas, plus interest for the time such individual was enrolled as a resident pursuant to this section.
