DAY TRIPS

Trip 1: Frida & Frank

Thursday, September 1st in Bartlesville & Tulsa, OK

Frida Kahlo and Frank Lloyd Wright – two pillars in the art and architecture worlds respectively – are the stars of our September trip. Heading southeast, we'll visit Frank Lloyd Wright's only fully realized skyscraper. Frank Lloyd Wright is called the greatest American architect of all time. Originally designed for downtown New York City in 1929, his Price Tower in Bartlesville has been named a National Historic Landmark. After lunch, we'll head south to Tulsa, OK, where we'll visit the Philbrook Museum of Art, housed in a historic Italian mansion and home to beautiful sprawling gardens. Their current exhibit on Mexican Modernism and Frida Kahlo, one of the 20th century's most iconic artists commonly known for her striking



self-portraits, details her life and work. Exploring how art and architecture impact society and the people in it, we will leave at approximately 8:00am and return to Cowley College around 6:00pm. Lunch is included, and the cost of the trip is \$45.

Trip 2: Ad Astra

Friday, October 21st in Yoder & Hutchinson, KS

The Cosmosphere is an international science education center and space museum. On this adventurous day trip, you'll get to take a trip back in time to the 1930s to sit in for an interactive show in the lab of Dr. Robert Goddard, the father of modern rocketry. Along with exploring the Hall of Space Museum, you'll tour our current night sky in the Justice Planetarium, and take a bird's-eye view of the sky in the documentary *Wings Over Water* in the two-story Digital Dome Theater. The rest of our trip is still being finalized so it'll have to be a mystery! Isn't there always a little mystery paired in with space exploration though? How fitting. The only hint you get is that it may or may not have to do with flight. We'll leave around 8:00am



and return to Cowley College around 7pm. An all you can eat lunch at Carriage Crossing in Yoder is included, and the cost of the trip is \$55.

Trip 3: Holiday ICT Friday, November 11th in Wichita, KS

Christmas ornaments, holiday shopping, and wild lights – we're preparing for December. Home to eight resident glass blowing artists, Karg Art Glass studio and gallery will kick off our day with a glass blowing demonstration. For an additional fee, you'll also have the opportunity to "blow your own" glass Christmas ornament. The studio is centrally located in Kechi so there will be time to explore antique stores, quilt shops and a greenhouse – all within a block's walking distance. In the evening, we'll head to the Sedgwick County Zoo Wild Lights. These one-of-a-kind lantern sculptures are larger-than-life and, in a few instances, interactive. While we will be at the zoo, resident zoo animals will not be in attendance. After perusing the lights



we'll warm up with a special hot cocoa treat. We'll leave at 1:00pm and return to Cowley College around 9:15pm. Dinner and hot cocoa are included, and the cost of the trip is \$35. Optionally, blowing your own glass ornament is \$35. You won't need to commit to this yet, but please indicate at sign up if you're leaning towards creating your own so they can be sure to be prepared for us. Additionally, please note: after the Nov. 11th trip is filled, a second trip day will immediately open. The second offering of this day trip will be identical to the first but on Wednesday, Nov. 30th.
