This agreement is made by and between, Northwestern Oklahoma State University and Cowley County Community College.

Northwestern Oklahoma State University and Cowley County Community College acknowledge their shared mission to provide quality higher education programs, which meets the needs of the region and provide highly trained professionals for the workforce.

The primary purpose of the 2+2 Agreement (see attached document) is to enhance the transferability between the Pre Nursing Program at Cowley County to the BSN Program at Northwestern Oklahoma State University. This agreement will provide guidance for both parties in advising students interested in pursuing a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing.

Modification of Agreement

This agreement shall only be modified in writing with the same formality as the original agreement.

Terms of the Agreement

The agreement will begin with the 2013-2014 school year.

Termination of Agreement

Either party may terminate this agreement for any reason with a ninety day written notice from either party.

This agreement represents the entire understanding between Northwestern Oklahoma State University and Cowley County Community College. Any changes, corrections, or additions to this agreement shall be in writing and signed by all necessary parties.

Students will enter, if accepted, into the BSN beginning their junior year.</p> <p>*Students will need a minimum of a "C" in all Gen Ed and Pre-Reqs and will need the overall GPA of 2.5 and Science GPA of 2.5.
