# Puzzlefest Competition

Entrants will receive math puzzles which they must solve by appropriately placing the pieces as quickly as possible. The side of each mathematical question must be placed next to the side with its answer so that when complete, the puzzle forms a recognizable geometric shape such as a triangle or hexagon depending on the puzzle given.

There will be multiple sessions, but only the first, second and third students to most quickly and correctly solve the puzzles across all sessions will receive prizes. Depending on the amount of time available, extra puzzles may be solved for “door” prizes in each session.

Puzzles, contestant number ID cards, pencils and paper will be distributed at the beginning of the contest. No other materials are allowed.

Puzzle pieces should remain in the manila folder until the official notice to begin is given. Contestants may not write on the puzzle pieces and doing so will result in disqualification.

To signal that you have completed the puzzle you must raise your ID card. You may only raise your ID card once. Once you have raised your ID card you may not rearrange any puzzle pieces.

Puzzlefest judges will determine the order in which ID cards were raised and whether the puzzle is correctly arranged. Judges will document the qualified times to determine the final winners.
