263.00 STUDENT APPEAL OF COURSE GRADES

The evaluation of student performance reflected in the final course grade becomes a part of the permanent student record of the College and is recorded on the College Transcript for the student. This grade is based upon several factors relating to the achievement of course objectives, as assessed by the instructor according to the policies of the College, and shall be considered final, unless an appropriate appeal is filed with the Vice President of Academic Affairs within 90 days of the original issuance of the grade by a student according to the procedure.
